N.B. The above analysis is only qualitative as the number of data points per vehicle varies with the speed of the vehicle and the data analysis tool performs simplistic calculations. i.e. the higher the vehicle speed, the fewer the data points.

Secondary counter at Pavenham Village Hall – Via Count

A comparison of vehicle data between the Via Count and the Sis Vario has revealed that the former appears unable to record vehicles travelling at speeds greater than around 90-95mph.
